Accommodation & Travel

Hotels

- Options will include 3 - 4 star hotel accommodation
- Hotels are located between 10 - 40 minute drive from the Kawana Sports Precinct
- Check-in from 2pm on Sunday 4 October 2026
- Check out by 10am on Sunday 11 October 2026
- Alternative check-in or check out dates and times can be arranged - additional cost will apply.

Room Configuration

- Twin-share rooms for athletes
- Single rooms for staff
- Additional single rooms may be available - additional costs may apply.

Airports Transfers

- Sunshine Coast Airport (MCY) is approximately 20 km - 20 minutes drive to Kawana Sports Precinct.
- Brisbane Airport (BNE) is approximately 95 km - 1 hour drive to Kawana Sports Precinct.
- While airport transfers from MCY & BNE are included in tournament package, bookings are still required.
- *Note: Arrival at any other airport other than MCY or BNE will be subject to additional costs*

Game Day Transport

- Bus shuttles or Team Vans will running between Hotels and Kawana Sports Precinct each day of the event

Visa Information

It is the responsibility of all participants and visitors to ensure they obtain the appropriate visa to enter Australia. Lacrosse Australia is working closely with the Australian Olympic Committee and the Department of Home Affairs to support participating nations with visa requirements and enquires.

Accreditation

All athletes and staff will be provided with Official Accreditation for the event, which must be always carried and presented for entry to the venue.



Event Costings

Team Entry Fee

\$20,000 USD per team will be invoiced by and payable to Lacrosse Australia.

- Participation Fee = \$10,000 USD (non-refundable)
- Accommodation, Ground Transport & Meals Package = \$10,000 USD

Participation & Accommodation Package

based on an official team of 15 = 12 athletes and 3 staff

- Event as per APLU Championship Guidelines
 - Opening & Closing Ceremonies
 - MVP Awards
 - Live streaming of games
 - Event promotions & exposure
 - Event Public Liability Insurance
 - Event photography
 - Meal Packages (at hotel and playing venue)
 - Vendor Village - if Teams require a merchandise area at the Venue and/or storage, an additional cost will apply.
 - Practice field bookings - as per each teams requirement, an additional cost will apply.
- 7 nights' Accommodation
 - Single room configuration - if Teams or Officials require single room configuration (not twin share), an additional cost will apply, subject to availability.
 - Additional Hotel nights - if Teams require additional nights of accommodation, outside the scheduled check-in and check-out, an additional cost will apply.
- Transport
 - Airport Transfers - LA will liaise with Teams to arrange airport transfers.
 - Shuttle bus and/or team vans from hotel to game venue each day
 - Bus Charter - if teams would like transport outside of the offered services, LA can provide contact detail with suppliers.
